Medicaid Changes Effective July 1, 2018

Kentucky HEALTH is the Commonwealth's new health and well-being program for eligible low-income adults and their families. If you are on Medicaid now, you will get more information in the mail before any changes are made. Depending on your personal situation, the following changes may affect you.

- Pay monthly premiums or copayments
- Changes in dental and vision costs
- Must meet new requirements which include 80 hours a month of activities related to education, job training, employment, substance use disorder treatment, or volunteering.

What do you need to do?

Watch for letters from DCBS that will inform you of any changes. Make sure DCBS has your current mailing address.

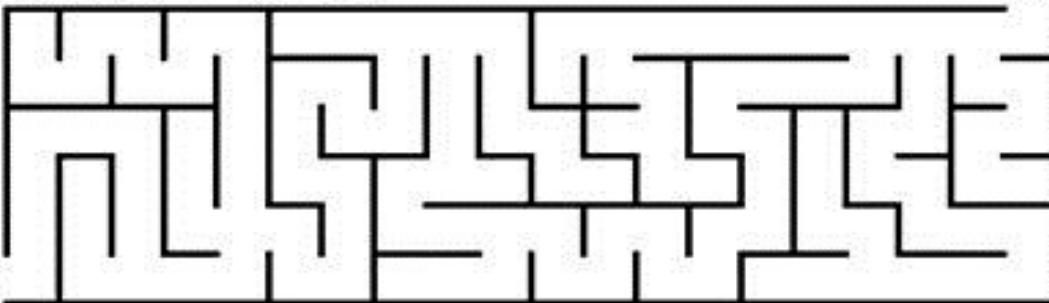
