## Medicaid Changes Starting September 1st!



Kentucky HEALTH is the new health and well-being program for some adults and their families. Some people will receive their Medicaid benefits through Kentucky HEALTH which starts for Kenton County residents on September 1, 2018.

Depending on your situation, the following changes may affect you:

- Pay monthly premiums or copayments
- Changes in dental and vision costs
- Must meet Community Engagement requirements: 80 hours/month of activities related to education, job training, employment, substance use disorder treatments, or volunteering.

What do you need to do?

- Watch your mail for letters that will inform you of any changes.
- Make sure DCBS has your current mailing address. Log onto [www.benefind.ky.gov](http://www.benefind.ky.gov) or call 855-306-8959 to report a change.
