Welcome 2020! The City Futures team is excited for the upcoming year and all the events and opportunities coming to the residents of City Heights. Whether you are interested in job training, career exploration, obtaining your GED, or enrolling in college, City Futures is here to guide you on your career pathway. We currently have 7 residents attending a job training program at Brighton Center's Center for Employment Training. Additionally, we have 2 residents looking to begin the Transportation Construction Certification program at Gateway. We are able to provide daily transportation for the trainees to attend these programs. On January 24th, Gateway Community and Technical College will be on site offering Community Leadership and Executive Skill training to interested residents. This is a 6 week program offered on Thursday evenings at the Recreation Hall. All participants will receive a certificate of completion as well as have the opportunity to earn the Kentucky Essential Skills Certificate, a state recognized credential that lets employers know a job seeker has completed this important job readiness program.
