

HOUSING AUTHORITY OF COVINGTON PARKING POLICY

PARKING RULES FOR TENANT-OWNED AUTOMOBILES

All automobiles owned by the residents must bear a Housing Authority parking sticker in order to park in designated areas for parking within the Housing Authority. These stickers may be obtained from the Housing Office, without cost, upon the presentation of proof of ownership (Registration Form), without cost. In order to receive a parking sticker, all vehicles must be registered in the State of Kentucky. Kentucky registration must be obtained within 30 days of moving into the State, as required by law.

In the event the automobile is traded or sold and is replaced by another, it will be necessary to obtain another sticker. The office will maintain, in the tenant's file, a copy of each sticker distributed, which will provide a complete description of the automobile.

The parking sticker issued by the Housing Authority does not protect your automobile from being ticketed by the Covington Police Department if it is not parked in the properly designated area. It is issued to allow parking on the Authority property and to identify the automobiles owned by the tenants.

The Housing Authority shall control all inoperable vehicles while parked in our designated areas. If your vehicle has been lame for any reason, this should be reported to the manager's office. No inoperable automobiles may remain parked in a designated area in excess of thirty (30) days without special permission from the manager. Violators' vehicles will be towed away at the expense of the owner. There will be one (1) warning prior to towing.

NO REGISTRATON ----- NO STICKER WILL BE ISSUED

Automobiles will be automatically towed without any prior warning if discovered parked on grass or other prohibited areas.
