The team at City Futures has been hard at work organizing new ways to serve and work alongside customers amidst a global pandemic. The team of City Futures is dedicated to exploring new ways to keep customers and staff safe, while still providing and being present with what the community needs.

This fall has been no exception. City Futures has been hosting Financial Wellness Workshops in the City Heights Rec Hall, each with a different theme regarding spending or saving money. These have proven successful and give residents the opportunity to present questions and learn more about practical ways to attain their financial goals.

These workshops are held every **2nd and 4th Wednesday** of the month from **5:30-7:30 pm, until November 11th, 2020.**

City Heights Community Update

We hope as many of you as possible are enjoying your new internet service that was recently installed in City Heights!! We also hope many of you are likewise enjoying the donated computers you received through the CompuDopt program! These tools will be very helpful for you and your family as you take care of business and work toward future goals. They will also help you keep in touch with community news and resources.

For those of you currently enrolled in the Jobs Plus/ City Futures Program, but still without a computer you own, you too may be eligible for a free computer! Many of our residents may not realize that the computers the schools provide are only “loaners.” You must return them at the end of the school year! To sign-up for a computer of your own, stop by the City Futures’ office, 2522 Todd, and complete a simple computer registration form verifying that you: **1)** are enrolled in the City Futures’ program, **2)** are actively working on a City Futures’ goal plan requiring the use of a computer, and **3)** do not presently own a computer. Take advantage of this opportunity!!!

Finally, as an update on the Disposition Project for City Heights, work continues on the application to HUD, the surveyor is completing a report to quantify the total acreage available for sale, and an appraiser is working to quantify the property’s value. We are also getting quotes on the cost of demolition and debris removal.

As stated in the September newsletter, now is the time to work toward your employment and training goals, pay off debt, establish good credit, and plan for *better futures!* The more you prepare, the more housing options you will have when it comes time to relocate.
