Attention Residents:

Starting October 2021, late rent policy will go back into effect as the moratorium expires. Rent and other charges are due on the 1st of the month with a grace period up to the 7th of the month. If the 7th falls on a weekend, it must be paid by Friday. Rent received on the 8th or after is subject to a \$20 late fee.

Rent received on the 18th or after is subject to an additional \$30 late for for a total of \$50.00. Rent must be received by the property management offices by the 7th, regardless of when the money order was purchased.
