Want to become a role model?

Northern Kentucky Community Action Commission is looking for individuals 55+ to participate in a new, paid, service opportunity in our Head Start Centers. Payment is in the form of a tax-free stipend that does not impact benefits. The program provides participants with the opportunity to become role models, mentors, and friends to the children enrolled; they help turn Head Start into a community. Participants do a variety of activities – there is something for every skill set. You can join children for breakfast, lunch, or snack, participate in classroom activities, support kiddos who need a little extra time and attention, or help bring learning and support into homes by assembling care kits (if being in a classroom is not your cup of tea). Schedules are flexible and will be made to suit your needs. More information is below:

Benefits of Participation: Participants receive a tax-free stipend (that does not impact benefits), mileage reimbursement, free meals on service days (if in a center), and free bus passes on service days. You will also form new relationships with people in our community and make a difference in the lives of others.

Eligibility: Be age 55 years or older. Be medically cleared to volunteer (clearance will be taken care of during the enrollment process, transportation will be provided) Pass state and federal background checks (background checks will be taken care of during the enrollment process, transportation will be provided)
